****MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS FOR CURRENT ACTIVE MEMBERS IS NOW OPEN****

- Membership renewal payment is due by 12-31-2020.
If renewal is not paid by January 30th, the initiation fee will be reapplied.
- New Members take part in orientation at an assigned time, receiving a new member packet, membership card/gate key.
- The gate to TCCC will only be accessible to paid current members as of January 1, 2020.
- One (1) gate key per paid membership.
- There is a \$10 replacement fee for lost keys.

Rules of the Range: Rules are posted everywhere on the grounds. As a member (we are a members' only club) you have agreed to follow the rules. You have agreed to keep the club clean. Abuse of club property or the use of unauthorized targets is prohibited and subject to revocation of your membership without notice. Your firearms are not loaded until you are ready to shoot.
